RECYCLED ART SCULPTURE CONTEST

In celebration of Earth Science Week, Patrick Henry Community College invites entries into the Recycled Art Sculpture Contest. Sculptures will be displayed in the Walker Fine Arts/Student Center Gallery from Monday, Oct. 13 through Thursday, Oct. 16, 2014 and must meet the following criteria.

- The contest is open to anyone who wishes to enter including small groups who wish to collaborate.
- Entrants are encouraged to create work completely out of recycled materials with the exception of fasteners and adhesives (glue, nails, staples, wire, string). For purposes of this competition, "recycled" means any material that has been used and is now repurposed for another use.
- Sculptures must contain no organic material subject to decay. Wooden elements are acceptable.
- Entries must be free-standing, structurally sound and stable.
- Entries must occupy no more than a 2 foot x 2 foot footprint and be no taller than 8 feet.
- Entry forms must be submitted to the college (276-656-0259, klandrum@patrickhenry.edu) no later than October 3, 2014 to enter the contest.
- Entries must include a label identifying the artist(s) name and the title of the sculpture.
- Entries must be delivered and set-up in the Walker Fine Arts/Student Center Gallery between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 13, 2014.
- Entries will be judged based on creativity, originality, quality of construction, presentation and artistic merit.
- Winners will be announced on Thursday, Oct. 16 at 1 pm. Entries must be removed from the premises between 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 16 .

First (\$100), second (\$75) and third (\$50) place prizes will be awarded!

Awards subject to the number and quality of entries.
