

F-1 AGREEMENT FORM

I, _____, ID OR SSN _____
understand the requirements listed below must be satisfied to meet the College and INS regulations:

1. Enrollment each semester (fall and spring) as a full-time student (a minimum of 12 credits) in a program of study.
2. Completion of a minimum of 12 credits each semester (this does not include courses audited, dropped, or withdrawn). If the course selected is closed or cancelled, enrollment in another course is necessary in order to maintain full-time status.
3. Maintaining satisfactory academic progress (2.0 GPA) is required.
4. Employment during your first year at PHCC will not be recommended based on your recent affidavit of support to cover tuition and living expenses.
5. Inform the college immediately of any changes that occur including name, address and program of study.

Failure to meet all these requirements may result in your I-20 being returned to INS.

INS REPORTING REQUIREMENT

Effective Fall 2002 semester, institutions in Virginia are required to report to the Office of the Attorney General all accepted students pursuant to student visa who fail to enroll, withdraw from a class or violate the terms of their visa. This is pursuant to HB364 Code of Virginia.

TRAVEL

You are required to make arrangements to have your I-20 signed/endorsed two (2) weeks in advance of traveling outside of the United States. This must be completed to allow reentry. Please check the visa page of your passport to ensure that it is valid, it has not expired, and it shows your current visa status. If you have changed your status, you must obtain a new visa from the American Embassy or Consulate before returning to the U.S.
