

## P&HCC F-1 Student Financial Statement

F-1 students must demonstrate sufficient financial resources to cover all educational and living expenses while enrolled at Patrick & Henry Community College (P&HCC). Students must submit a bank statement or bank certification form for themselves and/or their sponsor showing funds equal to or greater than the estimated annual cost.

Financial documentation must meet the following requirements:

- Issued by a licensed financial institution
- Show readily available liquid funds
- Be dated within six (6) months of the program start date
- Be in English or accompanied by a certified English translation
- Show all amounts in U.S. dollars

The following are not accepted: investments, retirement accounts, stocks, bonds, certificates of deposit (CDs), or statements from online-only or investment-based accounts (such as PayPal, cryptocurrency accounts, or digital banks).

### Estimated Costs Per Year: \$17,130

- Tuition and fees<sup>1</sup> : \$9,330
- Living expenses<sup>2</sup> : \$6,300
- Books and supplies: \$1,500

### Student Certification
