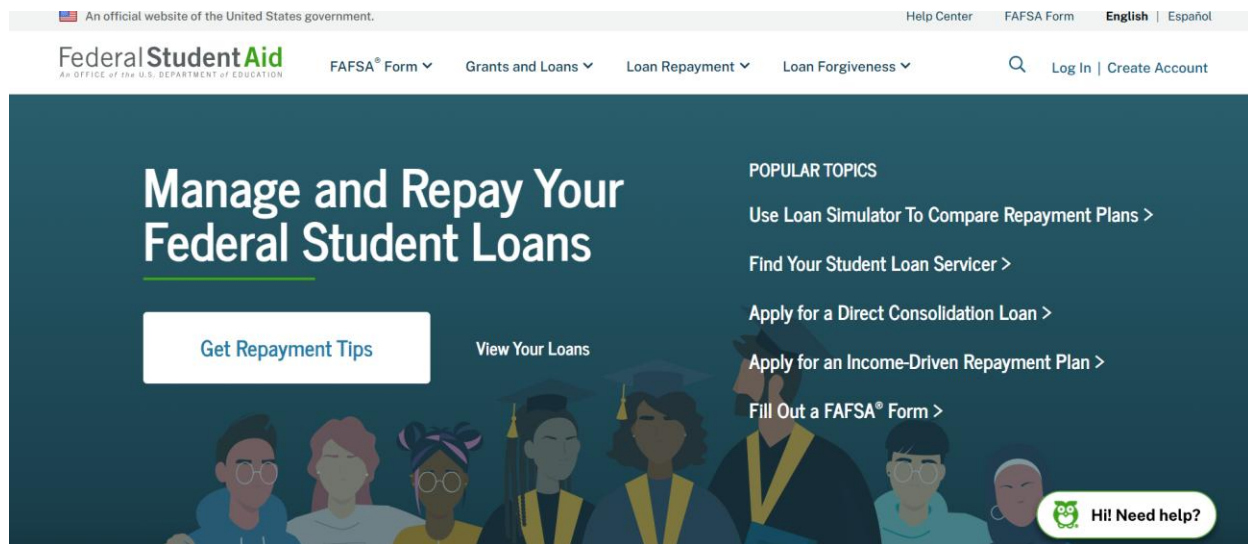


Accessing Your NSLDS Data

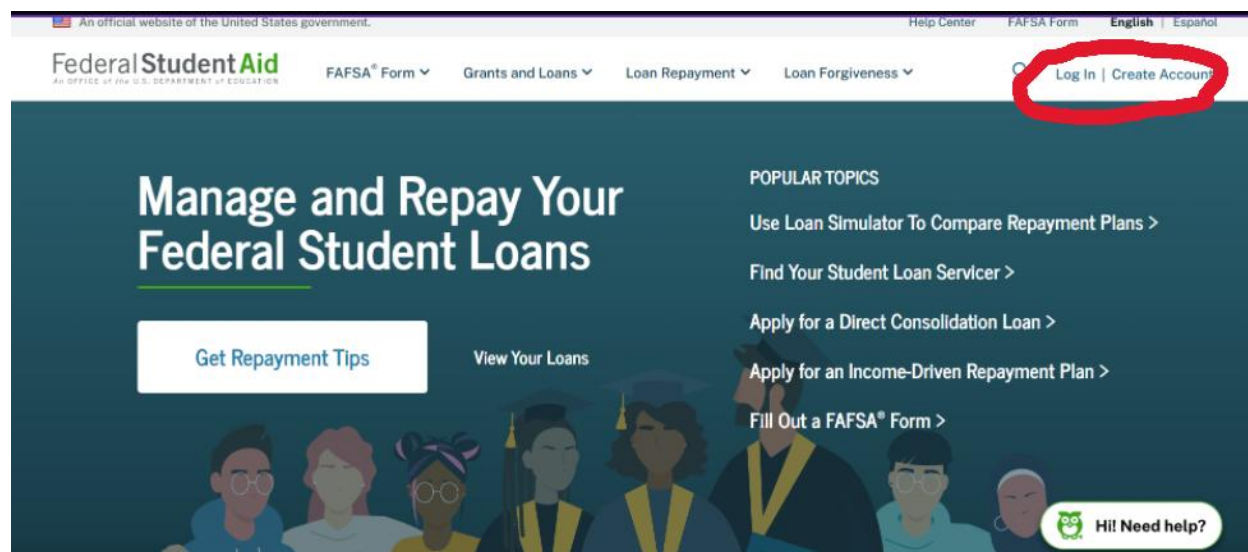
STEP 1: Navigate to the federal student aid website

- Go to the [Federal Student Aid website \(studentaid.gov\)](https://studentaid.gov) to begin.



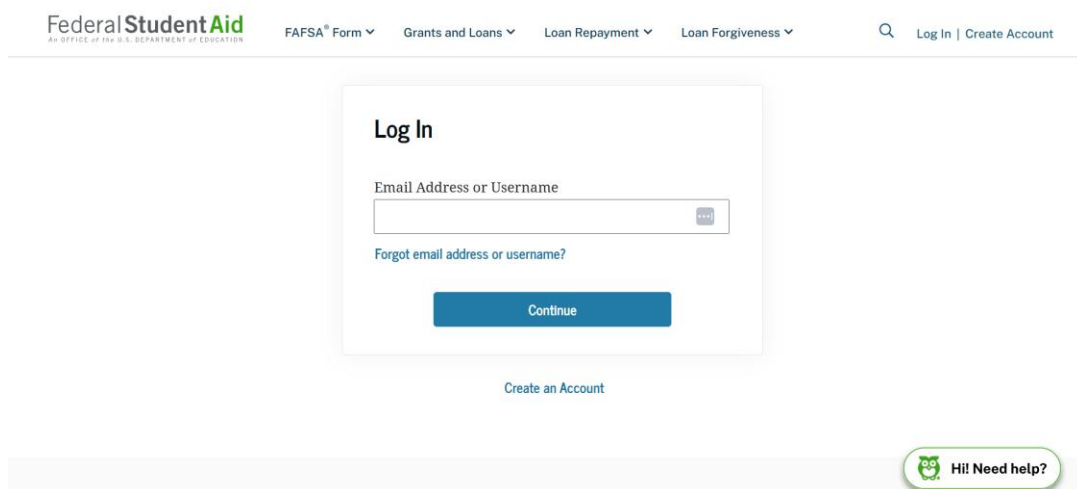
STEP 2: Log in to your account

- Click the Log In button in the top right-hand corner to log into your account, shown circled in red. If you do not have an existing account, click the Create Account button beside the Log In button, which is also shown circled in red.



STEP 3: Log in using your credentials.

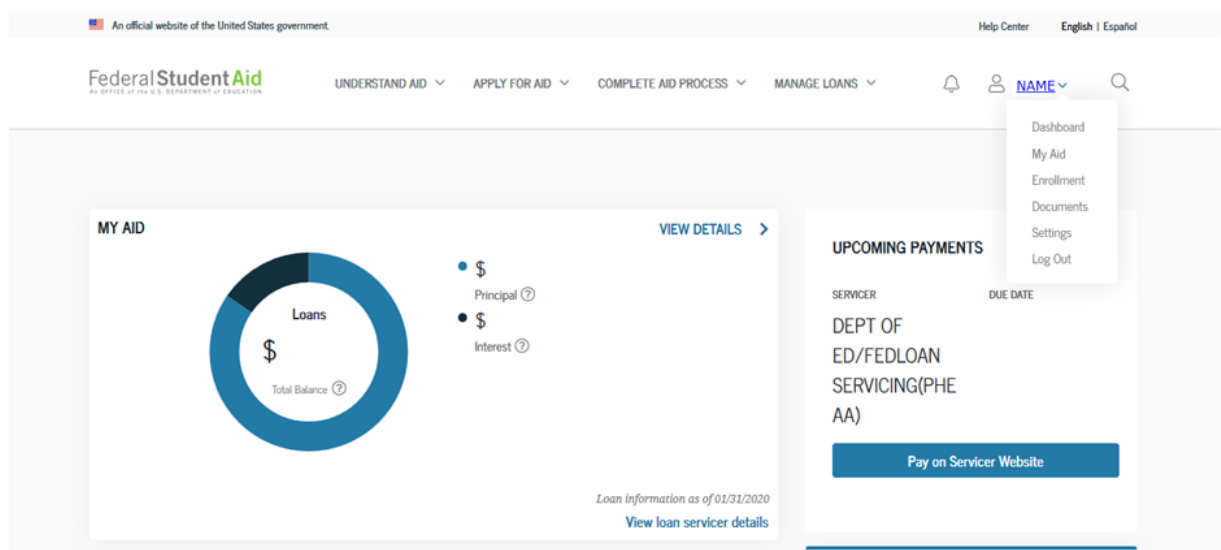
- Once you have clicked to log in to your account, a log in box will appear for you to enter your email address or username. You will need to enter a password after this. Note: You may have to verify your credentials with a code from a text message or email generated after logging in.

STEP 4: Click on your Name

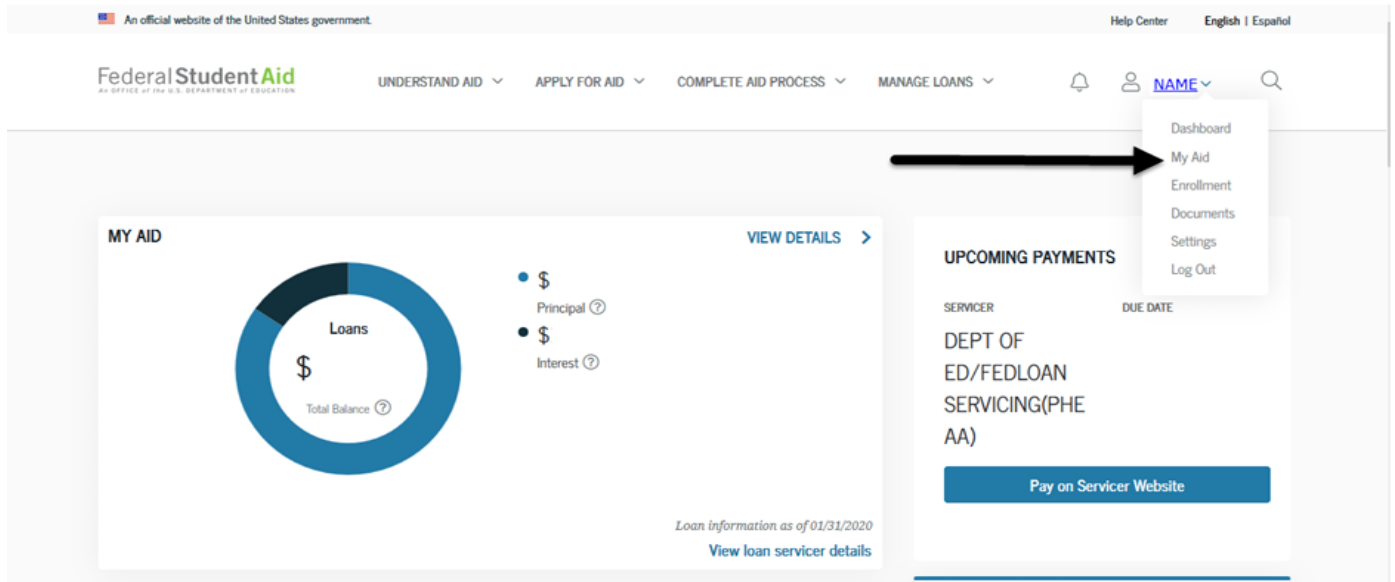
- Once logged in, you will be taken to your dashboard.
