All components of the COA are based on costs for a full-time student for a nine-month academic year. Additional expenses may be allowed for costs associated with physically disabled student's expenses, or costs associated with childcare expenses or other related expenses.

The components used to calculate a student's Federal Pell Grant cost of attendance (COA) are identical to those used to calculate COA for the campus-based programs. The COA is always based on the cost that a full-time student would typically incur during a full academic year.

## The out-of-state tuition and fees are based upon 12 credits:

- 5% increase in books
- Housing, Food, Food & Housing, Miscellaneous, Transportation - 2.4% cpi
- Less than 1/2 budget includes tuition, fees, books and 50% of allowable transportation cost
