

Breakdown for Pell Awarding:

For federal student aid purposes, full-time enrollment for programs offered in standard terms is defined by the institution and, for undergraduate students, must comprise at least 12 credit hours. Below is a chart of enrollment intensity relative to full time (defined as 12 credit hours) for financial aid purposes. Enrollment intensity only applies to Pell Grant eligibility. Enrollment intensity cannot exceed 100% for purposes of Pell Grant proration.
